## HOW TO MEASURE LITTLE FEET

1. Print this page at 100%, making sure your printer doesn't scale or resize. You can check by measuring the ruler on the right hand side of this page.
2. Ensure a steady supply of toys, snacks and other bribes are on hand to keep little feet still, and manoeuvre your child on to a hard surface with this paper on top.
3. Use a pencil to mark the point of the longest toe on both feet, and then use the lines to determine the correct Bimble size\*. If the feet differ go with the longest.

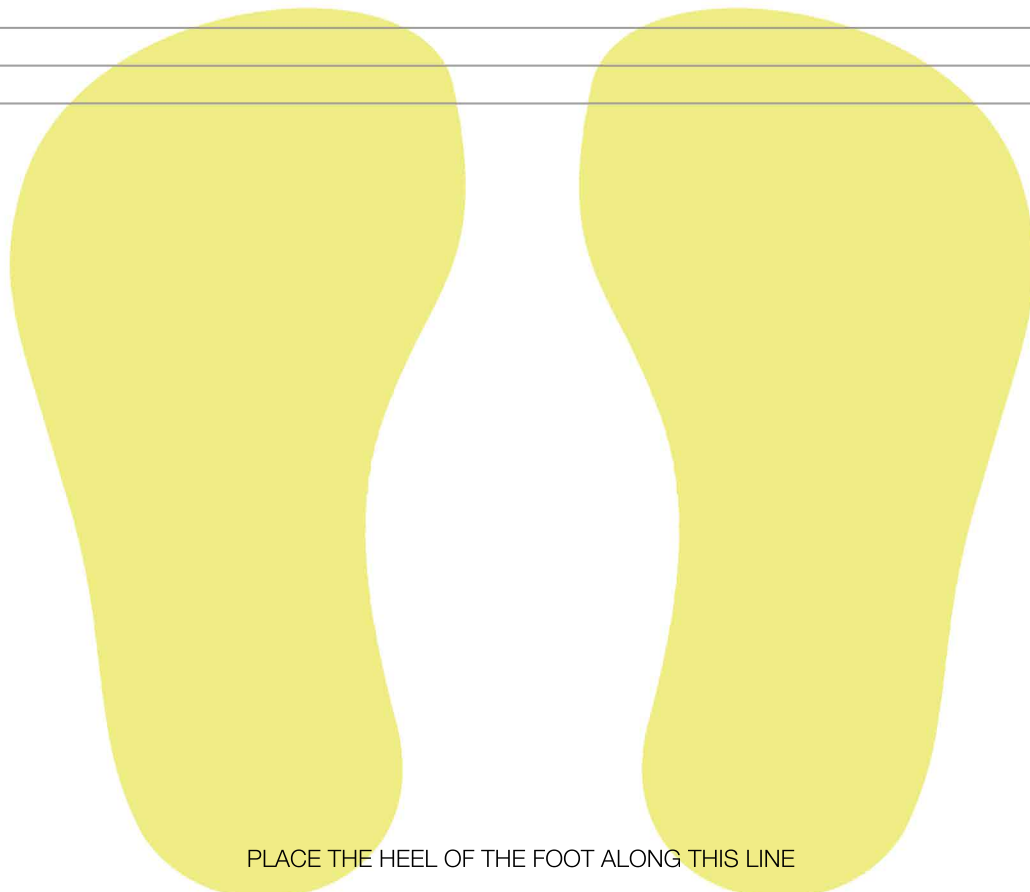
The lace up style of Bimbles allows a variety of foot widths to be accommodated comfortably, and you will find the leather flexes over time to the foot shape. Some people find they get more wear than with rigid shoe styles as the leather seems to 'grow' with the foot.

\* We have allowed some wiggle room, so for example, if your child's foot measures 11 cm, the size 3 shoe will actually be a little bit bigger.
